

## M.ED. READING TEACHER/READING SPECIALIST

Regis University's Master of Education in Reading program, with Reading Specialist and Reading Teacher added endorsement options, is designed to provide in-depth teacher preparation in literacy instruction for current K-12 educators. This fully online degree enhances the teaching of literacy through evidence-based best practices for all populations. The curriculum covers a variety of teaching strategies and assessments that help to meet the needs of a diverse student population, and prepare current teachers for literacy interventionist and instructional coaching roles. Areas of emphasis include multisensory instruction, literacy-specific learning disabilities such as dyslexia and dysgraphia, and using data to inform and individualize instruction.
