

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN CRIMINOLOGY DEGREE PROGRAM

The Master of Science in Criminology program teaches students to understand, prevent and anticipate criminal behavior. Offered online, on campus, or a combination of both, this degree explores the societal, political, and cultural factors that can cause or contribute to crime. Students will choose a specialized focus in behavior or cybercrime, tailoring their coursework to their interests and career goals.
