DOCTORATE PROGRAM

With our flexible online Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) programs, you can broaden your career options and equip yourself with a competitive advantage while you continue to work. As the highest clinical degree in the nursing field, a DNP can help position you as a leader among physicians, administrators and other health team members as you make decisions, lead others and influence change in an evolving health care environment. Total degree requirements (31-36 semester credits) are based on the number of clinical hours completed in your master's program.

REGIS OFFERS TWO DNP SPECIALIZATIONS TO ADVANCE YOUR CAREER GOALS:

Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN) – For nurses with an entry-level background as an advanced practice nurse with a minimum of two years of clinical experience.

Advanced Leadership in Health Care (ALHC) – For nurses with an entry-level background in nursing leadership with a minimum of two years of clinical experience.

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Courses are offered 100% online in 8-week terms and can be completed in a two or three year track. Classes start in May each year. Priority application deadline is December 1.
