

## MASTER OF ARTS IN COUNSELING

### DEGREE PROGRAM

This degree prepares students for careers as counselors who treat mental and emotional disorders at community agencies, nonprofit mental health agencies, child and family counseling centers, substance abuse centers and employee assistance organizations. The curriculum fulfills the requirements of the State of Colorado Licensing Board to apply and sit for the examination for the Colorado Professional License. The Master of Arts in Counseling program curriculum is accredited by CACREP.
