SCHEDULE OVERVIEW

Courses are offered Monday - Friday, during the day. This program can be completed in three years (eight consecutive semesters, including summers).

CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

38 weeks of full-time clinical exposure. 6-week clinical education in year II fall semester, 8-week clinical educations in year II summer semester, and two 12-week clinical educations in year III.
