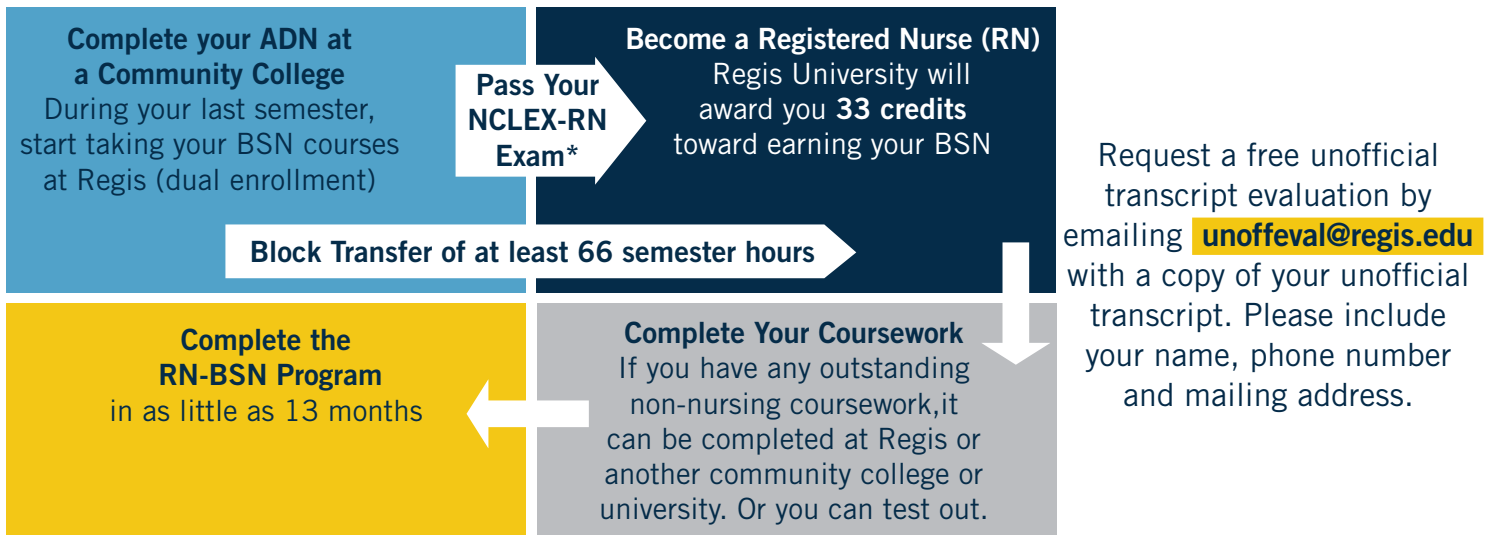
The RN-BSN programs focus on illness and disease management, health care ethics, community-based health and leadership while incorporating the Regis mission and Jesuit values. Regis University offers accelerated RN-BSN five-week OR eight-week cohorts designed to help you realize your objectives and talents in the shortest amount of time.

Perks of the Program

- > Earn your BSN in as little as **13 months** with 5-week accelerated terms.
- > Students can apply as early as their first semester in their ADN program at the community college and receive **dual admission** in the Regis five-week RN to BSN program.
- > **Dedicated Nursing Academic Advisors** will partner with you throughout your program.
- > A Jesuit education challenges you to think critically, engage in personal reflections, serve those in need, and treat the whole person.

We Give Credit Where Credit is Due

- > Registered nurses with an associate degree are given the maximum amount of credit possible.
- > **How it works:** if you completed an ADN from a regionally accredited community college with at least 66 credits you are **automatically awarded credit for the classes below, even if you did not take them.**

Earn both a BSN and Master of Science in Nursing with our RN to Master of Science in Nursing Leadership.
