

**Transfer Guide Covers Credits Earned from any Colorado Community College
Prerequisites for Doctor of Pharmacy**

The Doctor of Pharmacy program is 150 hours of full-time study, offered in nine semesters over four years.

Prerequisite work must be completed prior to matriculation in the School of Pharmacy.

A minimum of 66-72 hours of prerequisite course work is required prior to entry into the program. Total amount required varies depending on the completion of a bachelor's degree or higher.

Due to the dynamic nature of knowledge in the biological and chemical sciences, there is a seven-year limit on those prerequisite courses. However, this time limit may be waived if the applicant has a prior bachelor's degree or higher.

Students who will have a bachelor's degree at the start of the program need 9 electives and 66 total prerequisites.

Students without a bachelor's degree at the start of the program will need 12 electives and 72 total prerequisites.

**Religious Studies will be waived if the applicant has a prior bachelor's degree or higher.*

***Four-credit courses in General Chemistry I & II and Organic Chemistry I & II will be honored as long as lab is included.*

****Human Anatomy/Lab and Human Physiology/Lab can be completed as a sequence or a combined A&P I/Lab and A&P II/Lab as a sequence to fulfill this requirement.☑*
