#### Pre-Requisites for Doctor in Physical Therapy

*The Doctor of Physical Therapy program is 110 hours of full-time study, offered in eight semesters over three years.*

*Prerequisite work must be completed prior to matriculation in the School of Physical Therapy.*

*A minimum of 2.75 Prerequisite GPA is required. A 3.0 cumulative GPA is recommended.*

*Due to the dynamic nature of knowledge in the required prerequisite courses, there is a recommended five-year limit on prerequisite courses. However, Regis will consider all courses regardless of the amount of time since completion.*
