 - a. If you were here on a valid visa between the ages of 18-26, provide a student visa (I-20) or other valid U.S. passport visa stamp on a foreign passport with an expiration date (dates must be from entry until after you turned 26).
- 2) A letter of status from the Selective Service Administration (SSA).
- 3) A personal statement explaining why you did not register before you turned 26 years of age.

- 1) Documentation of when you entered the country, such as entry date stamp on the I-94 or in your passport, or a letter from the USCIS indicating your entry date.
- 2) A personal statement confirming when you entered the country.

- 1) Attach a copy of your birth certificate confirming the sex assigned to you at birth.
